

West Alabama Emergency Net – Regular Session

Calling all members of the West Alabama Emergency Net: this is <callsign> and my name is <name>. I will be your Net Control Station for this session and there is no emergency. This net is a function of the Tuscaloosa Amateur Radio Club and meets each Sunday night at 8:30 PM local time. 146.820 and 443.825, each with a tone of 118.8, are the primary repeater frequencies. In the event of an emergency, the 146.820 repeater will be the primary activation repeater. The purpose of this net is to provide a service to the Served Agencies of Tuscaloosa County and State in time of emergency. Before we begin, are there any stations with Emergency or Priority Traffic?

Is there any written traffic to list for the Net?

Do we have any business, bulletins, or announcements for the Net?

Do we have any mobile, portable, or short time stations wishing to check in?

Tonight’s net will be called by prefixes in alphabetical order, and all licensed Amateur operators are welcome to participate. If you have traffic or comments, please note your intentions when checking in. We will now start the roll call beginning with all:

NOTES FOR NCS

Pause long enough after each prompt to allow as many check-ins as possible, and listen carefully to minimize the need for repeats.

After each group of check-ins, be sure to acknowledge each one of them by reading back each callsign (not just his/her name).

Be sure to identify yourself at least every ten minutes, per FCC rules. Pay attention to the time.

Do we have anyone wishing to list any swap-shop items for the Net? Do not share dollar amounts on the air, please.
